Naming of the Curlews

We had some interest to name these birds so we have gone for a local touch and named the Curlew 'Koo', 'Wee', and 'Rup'! I don't know which birds have which legflags so I have named them based on their GPS tag number.

As you can see from the maps below, the birds are moving from the Yallock Creek roost site to the Jam Jerrup bay. The tracks show regular movements (as we might expect). I will plan on sending an update fortnightly and hopefully more often as birds do exciting things coming up to the migration season.
