Population: decreasing

. World: over 2,000,000 birds

UK breeding: 38-59,000 pairsUK winter: 420,000 birds

Status:

Summer breeder (uplands), passage migrant and winter visitor (lowlands).

Identification features:

- . Slim body
- . Small head
- . Delicate bill
- . White axilliaries in all plumages
- Forms large flocks in winter often with Lapwings
- . Call a plaintive single note 'püü'

Something to appreciate
