Pluvialis squatarola

Other names:

- . Black-bellied Plover (America)
- . Silver Plover

Conservation status:

. World: Least Concern. European: Least Concern

. UK: Amber

Population: decreasing

. World: 692,000 birds. UK passage: 70,000 birds. UK winter: 43,000 birds

Status:

Passage and winter visitor to UK estuaries and mudflats from their high arctic tundra breeding grounds.

Identification features:

- . Robust body
- . Large head
- . Heavy bill
- . Only *Pluvialis* plover with rear toes
- . Black axilliaries in all plumages
- . Found singly or in loose groups
- . May flock at high tide roosts
- . Call a three syllable 'peee-uu-ee'
